### Lewis Carroll

Lewis Carroll is a famous English writer and mathematician His real name is Charles Lutwidge Dodgson. He was born in 1832 in the village of Daresbury, England. Lewis was the eldest of eleven children. His father, a priest, grew his son's love for literature and learning from an early age. Lewis was known for his vivid imagination and storytelling abilities. He often told fantastical tales to his younger siblings.

As a child, Lewis was fond of games and outdoor activities such as fishing and hiking, which drove his curiosity about the natural world. He developed a passion for photography during his years of growing up. He took pictures of life around him, as well as portraits of his friends and family. However, his love for words made him special; he wrote poetry and short stories in his youth, which were very talented and creative, and sent them to magazines. William Shakespeare, one of the greatest playwright and poet, was born in Stratford-upon-Avon in England in April 1564. William was the third of eight children. His father, John Shakespeare, was a successful glove maker, and his mother, Mary Arden, came from a respected farming family. During his childhood, Shakespeare attended the local grammar school, where he learned about Latin, Literature and grammar, all of which would later influence his storytelling.

## Система оценивания проверочной работы

Для корректного выполнения заданий 1-3 требуется точное указание числовой последовательности. За каждое правильно установленное соответствие в заданиях **1, 2 и 3** участник получает **1 балл**. Максимальный балл за каждое из этих заданий составляет **5 баллов** (по одному баллу за каждый правильный ответ).

Оценка ответа на задание **4** осуществляется на основе критериев, учитывающих точность и полноту ответа.

### **Примечание.**

1. Оценка выполнения задания 4 (электронного письма) производится по критериям К1–К4 с максимально возможным количеством баллов – 10.
2. В случае присуждения 0 баллов по критерию «Решение коммуникативной задачи», оценка по всем критериям для задания 4 равна 0 баллам.
3. Если объем письма составляет менее 54 слова, то оценка по всем критериям для данного задания также равна 0 баллам. При превышении объема письма 77 слова, оценке подлежат только первые 70 слов, соответствующие требуемому объему.
4. При определении соответствия объема работы требованиям учитываются все слова текста, начиная с первого и заканчивая последним, включая вспомогательные глаголы, предлоги, артикли и частицы.

В электронном письме обращение и подпись также подлежат подсчёту. При этом:

- стяжённые (краткие) формы (например, she's, it's, don't, didn't) считаются как одно слово;
- числительные, выраженные цифрами (например, 7, 34, 2022, 245 381), считаются как одно слово;
- числительные, выраженные словами (например, thirty-four), считаются как одно слово;
- сложные слова (например, hard-working, south-western, home-made) считаются как одно слово;
- сокращения (например, USA, e-book, IT) считаются как одно слово.
